Player / Parent Conduct

We understand that SC Vistula Garfield provides premiere level competition and requires a more serious commitment from both the child and the parent(s). This includes making a commitment to attend all *practices and games*. Although the club strives to provide equal playing time, during these crucial developmental years, attendance at practices and games will affect playing time. Repeated unexcused absences from games or practices will lead to a suspension from the team and possible dismissal from the club.

For each practice the child must be prepared to practice; which means arriving 10 minutes prior to the start of practice with proper practice attire, ball and water only (there is to be no juice or food brought to practice or games). If a child has to miss a practice or a game, the coach must be notified as early as possible, at least 24 hours prior unless it is an emergency. Any practice or game missed without notification of the coach will be an unexcused absence.

For any age group there might be multiple teams and it is the decision of the coaches as to what team any child is selected to play for. Once the child is placed on a select team the decision is final and parents must respect and abide by the decision. During the course of any given season(s) the child's performance can allow the child to be moved to another team at the discretion of both affected coaches. Parents cannot approach any coach about their child playing or practicing with another team and the child can face a suspension or dismissal from the club for a parent doing so. There is a long term development plan for the club's players and teams are arranged to provide the best possible development of each child, team and club as a whole.

With respect to games, it is understood that children must be at each and every game, and arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to a game ready to play in proper game attire. What positions a child plays and how much playing time a child has are at the coach's discretion and in accordance with both the club and US Soccer guidelines. During a game a parent is not allowed to "coach" from the sidelines or belittle the referees or other team, including its fans. Parent coaching only creates confusion for the child and most times can be contradictory to the instructions of the coach. Repeated offenses will affect your child's playing time and lead to a suspension from the team or dismissal form the club.

At S.C. Vistula we have a 24 hour rule. No parent is to approach a coach about a game directly after the game. A time must be arranged with the coach for no sooner than 24 hours after a game for any discussion. This is in the best interest of everyone involved and avoids unnecessary heat of the moment conflict.

Dear Parents:

The philosophy of the Sport Club Vistula Garfield is solely focused on developing young players to the best of their abilities. Not every player can become a professional soccer player but over the years SC Vistula has developed players playing at the professional level and many children who have received athletic scholarships to college. To do so takes a lot of work, determination and the commitment from both parent and child.

SC Vistula not only offers your child a chance to learn and play soccer during the developmental years but also provides post scholastic competitive soccer teams that they can play for including the SC Vistula Eagles senior team which currently plays in the highest semi-professional level leagues and competitions.

SC Vistula's registration fee is significantly less than other surrounding premier travel clubs. Unfortunately, the registration fees do not cover all of the soccer club's expenses. However, the club does the best it can in keeping the registration fee low without affecting the quality of training. Therefore, donations and fund raisers are necessary to cover our costs. SC Vistula Garfield relies on the players' parents, relatives, and volunteers to assist and participate in fund raising efforts. We ask for you to:

- Support our sponsors which are listed on our web page.
- Participate in our fund raiser dance and other activities.
- Become a team manager or trainer.
- Be courteous and respectful during games (to avoid fines).
- Come to our monthly meetings (to be aware of what is going on and to voice your thoughts)
- Don't just drop off children at practice/games but observe to be able to reinforce positively

Any additional money that is raised throughout the year is used to benefit the teams through additional winter and spring tournaments. Individual teams can also participate in state cups and any additional activities or tournaments mutually agreed upon by the coach and a majority of the team's parents. Furthermore, individual teams can choose to seek team sponsors to help pay for the cost of uniforms or other team items. Anything purchased for the team must be according to the club colors and design specifications.

Players must bring a ball, shin guards, water, and a serious attitude to learn and train hard to each and every practice. Players must always respect all authority figures, including coaches, trainers, referees, administrators, and, above all, parents. Practices are MANDATORY. Please do not expect to play – unless you attend each scheduled practice with your team or a substitute practice.

Players must realize that this is not recreational soccer. Our training is the highest level of elite and developmental training. All coaching and player allocation decisions (team assignments) are made solely by the professional coaching staff of the club.
